

Wilfrid Laurier University Senate Ad-Hoc Meeting Summary: June 3, 2024 (Open Agenda)

This summary report is for information only and does not constitute an official record of the Senate meeting; the formal meeting minutes will be approved at the subsequent meeting.

The Senate approved:

- The discontinuation of the Senate Committee of Teaching and Learning as a committee of the Senate. The recommendation was made with the intention of restructuring its role to serve as an advisory committee to the Associate Vice-President: Academic, with amended mandates and terms of reference.
- The continuation, with review in three years, of the following University Research Centres and Institutes:
 - MS2Discovery Interdisciplinary Research Institute
 - o International Migration Research Centre
 - o Tshepo Institute for the Study of Contemporary Africa
 - o Centre for Leading Research in Education
- The continuation of the Centre for Community Research, Learning and Action, with review in three years.
- The continuation of the Manulife Centre for Community Health Research, with review in one year.
